School Placement / Work Experience Policy (Reviewed: April / May 2021)

Scoil Náisiúnta Chaisleáin Uí Liatháin is willing to accept students for school placement / work experience from second and third level colleges and will be accepted on a “first come, first served” basis, with a limit on the number of students accepted in any academic year, to be determined by and at the discretion of the Principal / Board of Management. In order to comply with Child Protection Policy and Garda Vetting Procedures, the following will apply:

- It is the responsibility of the individual and / or the placing organisation to obtain Garda Vetting for its students and to confirm in writing, by presenting the relevant documentation *prior* to the placement, that the vetting has been obtained and stating that there are no relevant disclosures;
- As students under 16 years cannot be vetted, it will therefore **not** be possible to accept such students for placement / work experience in our school.

This policy was reviewed by the staff as part of the Croke Park Hours' Schedule in April / May 2021. It was reviewed and ratified by the Board of Management in May 2021. It will be reviewed again during the course of the 2023 / 2024 school year or earlier if it is deemed necessary.
